- Increase percentage of students achieving A-C in English to 15% A, 30% B, 45% C in Yrs P-6
- Increase percentage of students achieving A-C in Maths to 15% A, 40% B, 40% C in Yrs P-6
- Increase percentage of students, on an Individual Curriculum Plan, achieving a 'C' standard or better in English and Maths to 90%
