OUR MEASURES

- For every student in Prep to Year 6, we will monitor:
- proportion of students receiving a SDA (maximising learning days)
- proportion of students receiving a C and above in English and Mathematics
- proportion of students achieving A or a B in English & Mathematics
- diagnostic PLD, PROBE, SA Spelling (Data Literacy Framework)
- proportion of students achieving above 95% Attendance
- proportion of students enrolling with transition statements



Each year our school improvement priorities from this plan are actioned through our Annual Improvement Plan (AIP). The focus may vary dependent on school-wide progress. - enrolment in extension/ intervention programs/ projects
- student Engagement & Wellbeing deliverables
